



Alma Louise Ashcraft

91 year old Alma Louise Ashcraft (nee Williams) known by most as Louise, went to be with the Lord, Sunday, July 1, 2012. Born in Williamstown, KY, she lived for awhile in Denver, CO, before adventuring to California where she settled in the San Fernando Valley. After surviving a major earthquake in 1971, she relocated in Colorado Springs, CO, where she retired from the United States Post Office in 1980 and moved back to Falmouth, KY.

While vacationing in Texas to attend her granddaughter's wedding and prepare for a permanent move there to be near family, she suffered a massive stroke and passed away a few days later. She was preceded in death by her parents, Delphus Williams and Ruby Lee Swarthwood; brothers: Gaines, Joe, Harold, Neal, and Bill, and her husband, Llano Carl Ashcraft.
