Arch Thompson, 98, of Berry, KY, passed away on Wednesday, October 15, 2014, at the Robertson County Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Mt. Olivet. Born on February 26, 1916 in Pendleton County, he was a son of the late Tommy T. and Stella Mae Hamm Thompson. On December 28, 1968, he married Chloeteen Martin Thompson, and his wife preceded him in death on July 7, 2010. A U.S. Army veteran, Arch was a train engineer with N & W Railroad, a well-known Pendleton County farmer, and a member of the Marcus Crooked Creek Baptist Church since 1930.
