Betty Reynolds Coleman, 93, of Edgewood, KY, formerly of Taylor Mill and Falmouth, passed away on Sunday, October 13, 2024, at the Maple Knoll Village in Cincinnati, OH, after a special visit with all of her children. Born in Falmouth, Kentucky on August 5, 1931, she was a daughter of the late Edward Earl Reynolds and Mary Frances Schuetz Reynolds.
