Betty Crofford Wilson, 89, of Berry, KY, passed away on Saturday, September 25, 2021, at the River Valley Nursing Home in Butler. Born on August 30, 1932 in Pendleton County, KY, she was the daughter of the late James and Daisy Barnes Crofford. On October 13, 1951, she married Roy Leland Wilson, and her dear husband of 63 years preceded her in death on April 8, 2015. A 1950 graduate of Morgan High School, Betty worked in Cincinnati, before returning to Pendleton County, where she worked on the farm, right alongside her husband and children.
