Born on March 29, 1962 in Campbell County, KY, he was a son of the late Phil and Janis Stewart Wiggins. A 1981 graduate of Pendleton High School, Brian worked as a carpenter, framing buildings, and as an employee of the former Barnes Hardware and Lumber in Falmouth.
