



## Bruce Hensley

December 28, 1936 - August 21, 2019

Bruce Hensley, 82, of Berry, KY, passed away on Wednesday, August 21, 2019, at his home. Born on December 28, 1936 in Barbourville, KY, he was a son of the late Lewis and Susie Reed Hensley. On June 25, 1960, he married Patsy Ruth Cowden Hensley, and his dear wife of 48 years preceded him on January 20, 2009.
