Charles Allen Cummins, 68, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Monday, July 29, 2019 at his home. Born on November 22, 1950 in Bracken County, Kentucky, he was the son of the late Charles William and Virginia Estelle Blades Cummins. A 1968 Pendleton High School graduate, Charles worked for R.A. Jones as a machinist and previously built furnaces for Williamson Heater, but his true passion was working on his family farm.
