Charles Marion Vallandingham, 83, of Edgewood, KY passed away on Friday, December 30, 2022, at his home. He was born on December 12, 1939, to the late William Arnold and Nancy Price Vallandingham. Charles grew up in Harrison County and spent much of his time working on the farm.

On March 20, 1960, he would marry Barbara Faulkner Vallandingham and they would spend the next 62 years building a wonderful life together. Charles was a truck driver and retired from ABF. He served as a Union Steward for Teamster Local 100 and served in various areas as a volunteer for St. Elizabeth Hospital.

Charles loved golfing, traveling, working puzzles, reading, and driving. He visited every state, except Hawaii, and traveled many times to see his favorite band, The Statler Brothers. Charles was a collector of match books, a member of the Latonia Baptist Church, and enjoyed NASCAR racing, even working security at the Kentucky Speedway. His life was well lived, and he will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

Along with his wife, Barbara, Charles is survived by two children: Melanie Wood of Highland Heights, KY and Grady Vallandingham of Edgewood, KY. 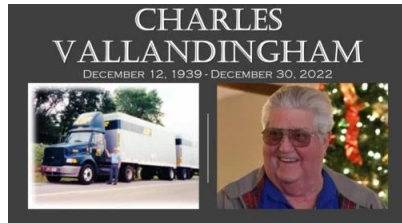
