Clyde F. George, 77, of Falmouth, KY went home to be with the Lord on Monday, November 15, 2021 at the Cold Spring Transitional Care in Cold Springs, KY. He was born in Hamilton, OH, on May 15, 1944 to the late Clyde Grant and Clara Felty George. He was a 1967 graduate of Cincinnati Bible College and Seminary and served in various ministry positions in Delaware, Virginia, and Kentucky. His roles included youth ministry, preaching ministry, and Camp Director at Camp Northward in Falmouth, KY. Clyde had a love for young people and was passionate about his Ohio State Buckeyes.
