CMSgt (Ret.) Patrick E. McAllister, 66, of Shiloh, Illinois, formerly of Independence, KY, died on Tuesday, March 26, 2013, at Memorial Hospital in Belleville, Illinois.

Born on October 18, 1946 in Cincinnati, OH, he was the son of the late Roger and Anna-Dean Webster McAllister. He is a 1964 graduate of Simon Kenton High School. Pat also graduated from the University of Maryland with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Management. On 20 April 1968, he married Janet Anne, the daughter of John and Dorothy Wetterhan. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a sister, Karen Dessecker.
