Everett L. Buckler, 78, of Berry, KY, passed away on Tuesday, June 12, 2018, at his home. Born on April 4, 1940 in Grant County, KY, he was a son of the late Alford and Roxie Robertson Buckler. On October 6, 1962, he married Gloria Bailey, and his dear wife survives his passing. Everett retired from the Transit Authority of Northern Kentucky (TANK) where he worked as a mechanic and driver.
