Felix Britton Ard, 64, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Monday, October 10, 2022, at his home after a courageous battle with cancer. Born on October 25, 1957 in Ft. Thomas, KY, Felix was raised in Rockcastle County, KY. For 10 years Felix worked with David Hosea Rigging, manually deconstructing buildings and moving/shipping them. He was fascinated with his work in tearing down the World's Fair in Knoxville, TN. In 1988, Felix was in a car accident, rendering him as disabled to continue his work. In his recovery, he met and married Mary Lynn Schultz on May 25, 1991. For the next 15 years, their purchase of two Tennessee Walkers blossomed into breeding, raising, and breaking these horses. Together, Felix and Mary enjoyed camping, hunting deer, fishing, and traveling out west to California, Wyoming, Montana, Utah, Arizona, and South Dakota, with memorable trips to Yellowstone and Sequoia National Parks. A gifted mechanic, Felix never tired of "tinkering;" he and a dear friend built two motorcycles out of Volkswagens.

Surviving to cherish his memory are his wife and best friend of 31 years, Mary; two sisters: Irene Blair (Gary) of Berea, KY and Gail Stewart (Garret) of Mt. Vernon, KY; one brother, Kelly Thompson (JoAnn) of Mt. Vernon, KY; one brother-in-law, Johnny Dailey of Somerset, KY; and a host of extended family and friends.

In addition to his parents, Floyd Ard and Emily Reams Burton, he was also preceded in death by his sister, Glenda Dailey.
