Gary Paul Pferrman, 67, of Falmouth, passed away on Tuesday, November 24, 2009, at his home. Born in Kenton County, Kentucky on October 8, 1942, he was the son of Bertina Giancola Pferrman and the late Harold R. Pferrman. He was a graduate of Newport Central Catholic High School. For 29 years he and his business partner, Susan Pferrman, have owned and operated Town and Country Floors in Falmouth, Kentucky. Gary was a member of St. Francis Xavier Church, a member of the Falmouth Lions Club, a life member of the Amateur Trap Shooting Association, and vice president of the Pferrman Gun Club.
