George Tucker, 93, of Walton, KY, formerly of Pendleton County, passed away on Tuesday, January 26, 2021, at his home. Born on July 21, 1927 in Dayton, KY, he was a son of the late George William and Louella Parker Tucker. He married Judith McDowell, and after 45 years of marriage, she preceded him in death in 1997. He was also predeceased by his son and daughter-in-law, David and Theresa Tucker.

George answered the call into ministry at a young age, and many churches have been blessed to have him as a pastor.
