H.A. Thompson, 84, of Berry, KY, passed away on Tuesday, January 25, 2021. Born on November 12, 1937 in Boyd, KY, he was a son of the late Hubert and Violette Cynthia Dunaway Thompson. On May 6, 1961, he married Margaret Louise Salyers Thompson, and together they farmed, raised their children, and offered a helping hand to friends and family.
