She was a loving mother, farmer, business woman, accomplished seamstress, and excellent cook.

Ina had a major stroke at the age of 78, which left her with limited speech and mobility. Ina's patience, determination and intelligence were profound. The

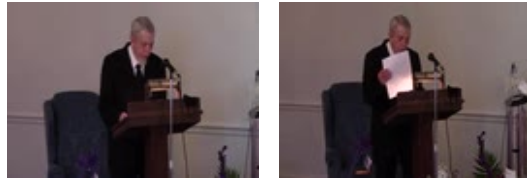
