Irene Mae Biddle Browning, 90, of Cynthiana, KY, formerly of Falmouth, passed away on Tuesday, January 12, 2021 at the Cedar Ridge Health Campus in Cynthiana. Born on May 2, 1930 in Bracken County, KY, she was a daughter of the late Harley Everett and Zelma Arnold Biddle. On March 18, 1950 she married Wallace Browning, Jr., and her dear husband survives her passing. Beginning in the mid 1960's, Irene worked as a beautician out of her house; she took wonderful care of all her clients, always going the extra mile to accommodate their needs. Formerly she worked as an office administrator for R. L. Polk and as a seamstress for Hyde Park Clothiers.
