Biography

J. L. Beyersdoerfer, 85, of Foster, Kentucky, passed away on Tuesday, June 9, 2009, at the River Valley Nursing Home in Butler. Born in Bracken County, Kentucky on October 25, 1923, he was a son of the late John and Nellie Cox Beyersdoerfer. On February 28, 1947, he married Sally Insko, and his dear wife survives his passing. For over 20 years he was a rural mail carrier in Foster and California, Kentucky. He was also a farmer. He owned and operated the Washington Trace Feed Mill, and he was a bee keeper. He was a member of the Pine Grove United Methodist Church, Pendleton County, a member of the Augusta F & A M # 80, a member of the Order of the Eastern Star #362 of Augusta, and a Kentucky Colonel.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters: Ada Browning and Freida Watts, and a brother, Bill Beyersdoerfer.
