James Kenneth Butcher, 91, of Cynthiana, KY, passed away at his home on Thursday, September 22, 2022. He was born on May 26, 1931 to the late Lester and Gladys McClanahan Butcher, and on October 27, 1972, he would marry Edna Jane McNeese. For almost 50 years, the two of them would build a life together, full of love, faith, and family. Kenneth was hard-working farmer in the Antioch-Richland area, an U.S. Army Veteran, a deacon and life-time member of the Antioch Mills Christian Church and served as the Vice President of the Board of the Pendleton County Farm Bureau.
