Jerry D. Myers, 74, of Falmouth, Kentucky, passed away on Sunday, July 13, 2008, at the Upper Valley Medical Center in Troy, Ohio. Born on September 7, 1933 in Georgetown, Ohio, he was the son of the late Raymond and Gertrude Mitchell Myers. He was an accomplished graphic artist and commercial illustrator. From 1955-1957, he attended the Central Academy Commercial Art School. He worked for Steinhauer Fisher from 1957-1977, after which he started his own graphic art studio, Miller Myers, working until his retirement in 1995. Jerry was a founding member of the Northern Kentucky Saddle Club and a Kentucky Colonel.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Patricia Bea Scaggs on May 24, 2002 and his brother-in-law, James C. Scaggs on August 11, 2006.
