Joan Elizabeth Aulick Angell, 76, of Falmouth, passed away on Monday, August 6, 2018, at the Villaspring of Erlanger Healthcare Center. Born on February 19, 1942 in Pendleton County, KY, she was the daughter of the late Paul and Mary Sullivan Aulick.
