Joseph Elden Blackaby, 79, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Sunday, December 11, 2016 at the Care Center at Kenton Pointe. Born on March 11, 1937, he was a son of the late Eldon and Marie Ostendorf Blackaby. On February 21, 1964 he married Jane Mains Blackaby and she survives his passing. He was a member of the New Hope Church of Christ, American Legion Post #109, Fraternal order of Police, and the Cynthiana Masonic Lodge. Joe was a lifelong servant to the community. He served in the United States Marine Corps as Military Police, and began his civilian career as an officer with the Falmouth Police Dept. He later worked for Harrison County and Pendleton County Sheriff Depts, and spent most of his career as an officer with Cynthiana Police Dept.
