Biography

Joseph Daniel Chalfant, 73, of Falmouth, passed away on Friday, January 14, 2011, at the University Hospital in Cincinnati, Ohio. Born in Pendleton County, Kentucky on February 11, 1937, he was a son of the late Serena Browning Chalfant and Monroe Daniel Chalfant. He graduated from Falmouth High School in 1956. On October 14, 1956, he married Pauline Hyatt and his dear wife survives his passing. He was a retired foreman with CAMCO Chemicals in Kenton County, a veteran of the U.S. Naval Reserves and the U.S. Army, and a member of the Oakland Christian Church, Pendleton County.
