Joseph Calvin Jennings, 77, of Alexandria, KY, took Jesus by the hand on Tuesday, October 5, 2021, at The Seasons @ Alexandria. Born on June 11, 1944 at home in Burlington, KY, he was a son of the late Joseph and Mary Wanita See Renkvish. Joe earned his Associates Degree in Mechanical Engineering at the University of Cincinnati, while working at Ford Motor Company in Sharonville, OH, where he retired as a supervisor after 42 years.
