Joyce Laverne Cooper Toliver, 73, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Thursday, November 4, 2021 at St. Elizabeth Health Care in Edgewood, KY. Born on April 23, 1948 at home in Falmouth, she was a daughter of the late Elbert Thomas and Helen Routt Cooper. On September 4, 1970, she married Elza Toliver, and her dear husband of 51 years survives her passing. A 1966 graduate of Falmouth High School, Joyce worked as the Literacy Coordinator with Pendleton County Schools for 20 years.
