Julia Kaye Woodhead Lawson, 68, of Falmouth, passed away on Monday, February 14, 2011 at her home. Born in Falmouth, Kentucky on July 19, 1942, she was the daughter of the late Joseph Woodford and Edith Roberts Woodhead. In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by two brothers: Joseph Martin and James Timothy Woodhead.

A graduate of the Falmouth High School Class of 1960, she retired from the St. Luke Alcohol and Drug Center as head cook in January 2011. Since 1966, she was also a licensed funeral director with Woodhead Funeral Homes. She was a part of the fourth generation of her family to serve the community in funeral service. She was a lifelong member of the Falmouth United Methodist Church, where she was active in a variety of roles including being a trustee and treasurer for the Book of Remembrance. She was a member of the Hardin- Browning Post #109 Ladies Auxiliary, a charter member of the Pendleton Country Club, and a Kentucky Colonel.

She loved to play golf. She will always be remembered for her support of others through all of the cards and notes she sent so faithfully to her family and friends.
