Larry Lee Florence, 74, of Falmouth, Kentucky, passed away on Thursday, December 2, 2010, at the Hospice of St. Elizabeth Health Care in Edgewood. Born in Bracken County, Kentucky on March 24, 1936, he was the son of the late Virgil Ora and Cornelia Elizabeth Taylor Florence. He was a truck driver, retiring from Averitt Express; a former Chief of the Falmouth Fire Dept. from 1982-1984, having served as a firefighter with the dept. for 35 years; a former Pendleton County Deputy Sheriff, and a former Falmouth police officer. He was a deacon and member of the Oakland Christian Church, Pendleton County, and a 42 year member of the Orion Lodge #222, F & A M.
