She began her teaching career at Butler Elementary School where she also sponsored the 7th and 8th grade cheerleading squad. She worked developing the Kentucky Junior Historical Society as well. Linda also taught at Pendleton Middle School and Pendleton High School where she sponsored the student council. She finished her education career working as an instructional supervisor at the central office. While providing services to the Pendleton County School System, Linda was also co-owner of the Ben Franklin Store (V & S Hardware) in Falmouth. After retirement from the school system, Linda sold real estate through Century 21. She was a member of the Mt. Moriah Christian Church and the Pendleton County Retired Teachers Association.
