Lois Lavon Askin Fields, 86, of Milford, passed away on Friday, December 9, 2022, surrounded by all of her loved ones. Born on July 17, 1936, she was the daughter of the late Finley and Blanche Kabler Askin. On June 26, 1954, she married Robert Wayne Fields, and her dear husband of 59 years preceded her in death on March 13, 2014. A graduate of Bracken County High School, she earned a Bachelors Degree in Education from the University of Kentucky.
