### Biography

Lona Edith Kemplin, 89, of Wilder, Kentucky, formerly of Peach Grove, passed away on Sunday, December 14, 2014, at the home of her granddaughter. Born in Montgomery County, KY on April 4, 1925, she was the daughter of the late Allen and Mayme Cochran Willoughby. A Camargo High School graduate, Lona earned her Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Kentucky. On July 14, 1945, she married William L. Kemplin, and he preceded her in death.
