Loretta Morris Simpson, 87, of Falmouth passed away on Friday, February 12, 2021 at the Cedar Ridge Nursing Home in Cynthiana, KY. She was born on July 10, 1933 to the late Batson and Cassie Donahue Morris. On April 17, 1954 she would marry her husband Ralph Simpson and the two would spend the next 47 years together, building a family and creating many memories, before his passing on September 25, 2001.

Loretta was a very active member of the Blanket Creek Baptist Church and served in numerous roles there.
