



## Mansion Begley

June 28, 1927 - August 31, 2007

Mansion Begley, Jr., 80, of Falmouth, Kentucky, passed away on Friday, August 31, 2007, at the St. Luke Hospital East Hospice Unit in Ft. Thomas, Kentucky.
