Marcella Ramsey Latimer, 85, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Thursday, December 27, 2018, at her home. Born on March 10, 1933 in Bracken County, KY, she was a daughter of the late Ercel Lee and Hildred Elizabeth Cummins Ramsey. On January 23, 1954, she married George Ross Latimer, and her dear husband of 56 years preceded her in death on February 16, 2010.

Marcella loved cooking and baking. During high school, she started working at the former Trolley Restaurant in Falmouth. She worked at the former Southern Belle Restaurant and owned the Kentucky Restaurant for 10 years. She was a familiar face at the former Stop-N-Tell Restaurant, working with the late Imogene Jacob, and she helped her daughter Pam Latimer at Nellie's Restaurant. 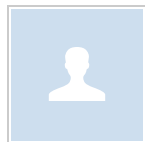
