Mary K. Reynolds Gronotte, 86, of Covington, KY, passed away on Friday, August 30, 2013, at the Providence Pavilion in Covington. Born in Pendleton County, KY on August 24, 1927, she was a daughter of the late Edward Earl and Mary Frances Schuetz Reynolds. She married Joseph B. Gronotte on Sept. 24, 1958 and her dear husband preceded her in death on August 24, 1986.
