



## Max Goldberg

April 5, 1913 - December 28, 2007

Max Goldberg, 94, of Falmouth, passed away Wednesday, December 19, 2007 at the Life care Center in Morehead, KY. Born on April 5, 1913 in Pendleton County, Kentucky, he was a son of the late Sol and Jennie Goldberg, who emigrated from Russia. For 41 years, he served as the Mayor of Falmouth. He owned and operated the Maysville Opera House in Maysville, KY and the Past Time Theater in Falmouth. He owned several properties in Falmouth, KY and Knoxville, TN. He was a veteran of the US army Air Corps where he fought during World War II in the Battle of the Bulge and was shot down twice.

He is survived by 1 nephew; Stephen Goldberg of Morehead, KY, 2 great nephews; Howard and Bradley Goldberg and 1 grand nephew; Hayden Goldberg.
