October 26, 1920 - July 12, 2020

Maybelle Sharp Sandy, 99, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Sunday, July 12, 2020 at the River Valley Nursing Home in Butler. Born on October 26, 1920 in the Lenoxburg Area of Pendleton County, Maybelle was a daughter of the late Dennie and Rosa Nell Routt Sharp. A 1938 graduate of Falmouth High School and the third oldest alumna of the school, Maybelle babysat and did household work for various families in Falmouth while attending high school. On April 27, 1940, she married John Wilbur Sandy, and her dear husband of 45 years preceded her in death on July 11, 1985. John and Maybelle spent most of their married life on the farm or in the country.

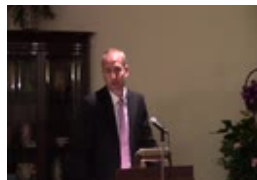
