



## Nelson C. Hill

February 7, 1910 - January 5, 2010

Nelson C. Hill, 99, of Falmouth, passed away on Tuesday, January 5, 2010, at his home. He was born in Harrison County, Kentucky on February 7, 1910. In 1967, he married Louella Haley Hill and his dear wife survives his passing. He was a U.S. Army veteran, having served during World War II. For 32 years, he was a lineman with Harrison County Rural Electric. Later he worked for many years as a kitchen installer with Howard Hoess at the former Sears & Robuck in Cincinnati, Ohio.

He preached at the former Church of the Nazarene in Falmouth. He was the oldest veteran in Pendleton County, a lifetime member of the Hardin-Browning Post #109, where he faithfully served on the firing squad at the age of 91, a lifetime member of the VFW, and a Kentucky Colonel.

In addition to his wife of 42 years, Louella Haley Hill, he is survived by his daughter, Joyce (Charles) Juett of Florida; his sister, Ruby Lyons of Cynthiana; 2 grandsons, several great grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 9, 2010, at the Woodhead Funeral Home, Falmouth. The visitation will be from 5-8:00 p.m. on Friday at the funeral home. Interment with full military honors by the Hardin-Browning Post #109, will take place in the Riverside Cemetery, Falmouth.
