



## Dr. Peter Fullwood

September 24, 1929 - April 22, 2007

Dr. Peter Fullwood, 77, of Falmouth, passed away on Sunday, April 22, 2007, at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center South in Edgewood. Born on September 24, 1929 in Chesterfield, England, he was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Albert Fullwood. He married Myra May Fullwood on July 14, 1956, and his wife preceded him in death on October 30, 2002. As a young man he served in both the British Navy and the Rhodesian Army. In 1967 he graduated from the Palmer Chiropractic College in Davenport, Iowa. He was a licensed chiropractor from 1967-2007, practicing independently in Falmouth. He attended the Falmouth United Methodist Church.

He was a former Mayor of Falmouth; former 8 year member of Falmouth City Council; past president and member of the Pendleton County Mental Retardation Board, past president and member of the Falmouth Rotary Club, past president and member of the Falmouth Lions Club, and past president of the Pendleton County Child Abuse Task Force. He was honored as a Kentucky Colonel.

He is survived by one daughter, Elizabeth Myra Ramsey (Clayton) of

Falmouth; two sons: Mark Fullwood (Jackie) of Falmouth and Pete Fullwood (Karla) of Ft. Thomas; seven grandchildren: Christopher Clayton Ramsey, Peter Mark Ramsey, Benjamin Albert Fullwood, John Albert Fullwood, Marleigh Fullwood, Jaycie Fullwood, and Clayton Ramsey; and four great grandchildren: Nathan Ramsey, Braden Ramsey, Derek Ramsey, and Kyle Ramsey.
