Raymond Leon "P. John" Ramsey, 81, of Falmouth, KY, passed away peacefully after a long life filled with love, experiences, and adventures on Sunday, December 12, 2021. Born in Bracken County on April 20, 1940, he was the youngest child of the late Virgil and Nicey Teegarden Ramsey.
