Richard Feldmann, 86, of Findlay, Ohio and formerly of Marion, Ohio passed from this life at his home on February 11, 2012, surrounded by family members. He was born December 6, 1925, in Newport, Kentucky to the late Herman and Mary Feldman. Richard graduated from St. Joseph's Prep School in Bardstown, Kentucky in 1942.
