Robert (Bob) Alvin Bertram, 90, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Wednesday, March 27, 2013, at the Robertson County Health Care Facility in Mt. Olivet, KY. Born in Cold Spring, Kentucky on July 25, 1922, he was the son of the late Henry and Mary Bertram. A well-known Pendleton County farmer, and former employee of the Pendleton County Road Department, he faithfully served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II.
