Ronald A. Burris, 74, of Florence, KY, formerly of Falmouth, passed away on Friday, December 11, 2020, at St. Elizabeth Health Care East in Ft. Thomas. Born on June 13, 1946 in Falmouth, he was a son of the late Roy Stanley and Wilma Beagle Burris. On February 22, 1969, he married Wanda Florence Burris, and his dear wife survives his passing.

A 1964 graduate of Falmouth High School, Ron worked as a supervisor with Ronan Engineering in Independence, KY retiring at age 62. Previously, when he was living in Palm Harbor, FL, he worked as a supervisor with Moog for nine years. Ron was a member of Florence Baptist Church, and he served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War.

In addition to his wife and best friend of 51 years Wanda, he is survived by his sister, Brenda Courtney of Villa Hills; his brother Gary (Paula) Burris of FL; sisters-in-law: Ruby (Ronnie) Stanfield of Butler, Sharon (Gennie) Gillespie of Alexandria, and Alta Conrad of Falmouth; several nieces and nephews; and a host of extended family and friends. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by three brothers-in-law: Ronnie Courtney, Billy Conrad, and Bobby Florence, Jr.; two sisters-in-law: Betty Florence Taylor and Judy Burris; and his father and mother-in-law: Robert and Bertha Florence.
