



## Roz Downard McClanahan

October 30, 1953 - June 4, 2020

Roysland “Roz” Downard McClanahan, 66, of Foster, KY, passed away on Thursday, June 4, 2020, at the University of Kentucky Chandler Medical Center in Lexington. Born on October 30, 1953 in Brooksville, KY, she was a daughter of the late Roy B. and Jeanetta Sharp Downard. Roz graduated from Bracken County High School and married her best friend Larry “Poncho” McClanahan on February 20, 1971. 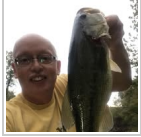
