Biography

Sarah Jo Sullivan, 34, of Falmouth, passed away on Saturday, December 24, 2011, at the Harrison Memorial Hospital in Cynthiana. Born on April 29, 1977 in Harrison County, Kentucky, she was the daughter of Larry Nichols of Falmouth, and the late Bonnie Jo Nichols, who preceded her in death on April 19, 1988. On August 8, 1998, she married Wesley Sullivan, and her husband survives her passing.

She was a graduate of Pendleton High School, and the University of Kentucky, where she also earned her Masters Degree. She received her Rank I from Northern Kentucky University. She was a member of FCCLA and Big Brothers Big Sisters. Sarah was a beloved teacher in the Pendleton County School system, a member of the Roanoke Christian Church, and an inspiration to all who knew her.

In addition to her husband of 13 years, Wesley Sullivan, and her father, Larry

Nichols, she is survived by her son, Cody James Sullivan; her brother, Jamie Michael (Allison) Nichols of Foster, KY; and a host of extended family and friends.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 29, 2011, at the Woodhead Funeral Home, Falmouth, with Bro. Clay Sullivan and Bro. Dale Bobb officiating.
