Stephen Phillip Wood, 57, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Sunday, December 16, 2018, at his home. Born on January 3, 1961 in Ft. Thomas, KY, Steve was the son of Phillip Wood and the late Nancy Lee Gulick Harville. A 1979 graduate of Pendleton High School, Steve worked at the Receiving Station in Maysville for over 20 years, and he started building barns with his father-in-law, Melvin Wright in 1982. On November 3, 1979, he married Dawn Wright, his dear wife and best friend survives his passing. Together, they created and operated Southern Ties for the last four years. Steve was a faithful member of the Morgan Christian Church, where he led worship for many years. Steve's journey was an inspiration. His genuine, loving spirit will always be remembered by those who knew him.
