April 13, 1954 - August 15, 2015

Steven Dale McNees, 61, of Falmouth, passed away on Tuesday, August 18, 2015. Born on April 13, 1954, in Pendleton County, KY, he was a son of Marjorie Hiles McNees and the late Charles McNees (April 20, 1998). Steven graduated from the last graduating class of Elgin High School in 1972. He was an electrician and worked as the head of maintenance at New Trier High School in Skokie, IL. His true passion was music. At the age of 9, he started playing the guitar, and his talent was recognized early in Pendleton County, when he and his friends won the 4-H Talent Contest playing “Secret Agent Man.” Over the years, he has played lead acoustic and electric guitar with many bands including Shadows of Time and Misty Water Creek. When he wasn’t playing music, he was fishing wherever and whenever they were biting. He has been known to fish into the dark with glow-in-the-dark lines.

In addition to his father, he was preceded in death by a sister, Lois McNees on April 27, 2004. On Jan. 20, 1973, he married Betty Jean “Jeanie” Davis, and to their union two children were born who survive his passing, Gina Lynn McNees of Sycamore, IL and Steven Dale McNees, II of Carpentersville, IL. He is also survived by his mother, Marjorie McNees of Cold Spring, KY, formerly of Falmouth; his fiancée’, Katy Vickers of Falmouth; 1 sister: Connie Peed of Foster, KY; 1 brother, Rick McNees of Kirkland, IL; several nieces and nephews; his best friend since childhood, Gary Wayne Oliver of Falmouth, KY; and a host of extended family and friends.
