Terri Lee Delaney, 56, of Covington, KY, passed away on July 29, 2020 at her home. Born on October 23, 1963 in Covington, she was a daughter of the late George Thomas and Patricia Ann Upthegrove Delaney and the late Phyllis Kay Lewis Jones. She earned a B.S. Degree in Nursing from Thomas More University, and she was the former Director of Pricing and Reimbursement with PharMerica.
