October 6, 1959 - February 23, 2023

Prince Tod Perrin, 63, of Williamstown, KY, passed away on Thursday, February 23, 2023. Born on October 6, 1959, in Cynthiana, KY, Tod was the son of the late Carlos Gene and Mary Louise Dunaway Perrin. A 1978 Harrison County High School graduate, Tod owned and operated Dixie Lawn & Landscaping for many years. Most recently, he worked as a forklift driver with area shipping and freight companies.

Remembered as a peaceful, free-spirited and tender-hearted man, Tod died unexpectedly at home where he spent most of this time, listening to music, playing guitar, and living simply. 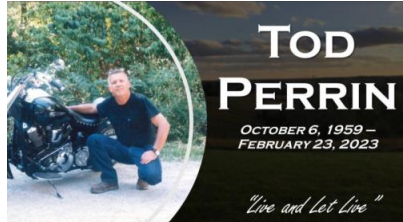
