Vicky Ann Justice, 50, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Thursday, May 16, 2019. Born in Covington, Kentucky on August 8, 1968, she was the daughter of Arnold Carroll, Sr. and the late Glenna Faye Brown Carroll. A 1986 graduate of Pendleton High School, she devoted her career as a dispatcher for 23 years, serving 12 years in Campbell County, and she worked for the Pendleton County Ambulance Service for 15 years. Vicky lived a life of service to her family, friends, and community, always putting the needs of others first. For many years, she participated in the Kentucky Firefighter Peer Support Group. On December 19, 2005, she married Tony Justice, and her dear husband survives her passing.
