Virgil Keith Fardo, 73, of Butler, KY, passed away on Friday, September 12, 2014, at the Hospice of St. Elizabeth Health Care in Edgewood. Born in Butler, KY, on August 11, 1941, he was the son of the late Kenneth and Garnet Kyle Shoemaker Fardo. A 1959 graduate of Butler High School, Keith married Patricia Trankler on August 8, 1959, and together they raised four children.
